

## JAMES A. HENDRICKS

Jim Hendricks is the Square D Emeritus Professor of Accountancy at Northern Illinois University. He has an undergraduate degree in accounting from Northern Illinois University, an M.B.A. from Indiana University, and a Ph.D. from the University of Illinois. He was a CPA in the State of Illinois and has six years experience in managerial accounting.

Jim's research focused primarily on current issues in cost management including all aspects of cost accounting related to factory automation such as capital budgeting, product costing, and performance measurement. Other research areas included the ethics of accounting research and the impact of human resource accounting information on investment decisions. His articles were published in The Accounting Review, Management Accounting, Cost and Management, Managerial Planning, The Auditor's Report, Journal of Accounting Education, Mechanical Engineering, and Industrial Engineering. Five of Jim's articles received national awards from the Institute of Management Accountants. He was a co-author of the monograph Cost Accounting for Factory Automation published by the National Association of Accountants.

Jim primarily taught several cost management courses at the undergraduate, MAS, MBA, and Executive MBA levels. He received Excellence in Teaching Awards at NIU at the undergraduate level from the Accountancy Department and from the University as a whole. He received the NIU College of Business Excellence in Teaching Award and the NIU Executive MBA Program Excellence in Teaching Golden Apple Award.

Jim was named an NIU Accountancy Department Outstanding Alum in 2001. The Jim and Kathy Hendricks Endowed Scholarship in Accountancy was established in 2002. He has been a member of the NIU Accountancy Executive Advisory Council since 2003.
